Des Plaines, IL- ICCP and TDWI ANNOUNCE RELEASE OF NEW CREDENTIAL

The Data Warehousing Institute and the ICCP have partnered to develop the Certified Business Intelligence Professional (CBIP) designation.

There are two levels of the CBIP available:

The **Certified Business Intelligence Professional - Practitioner Level** is awarded when a person passes three ICCP Examinations at the 50% or higher score. The **Certified Business Intelligence Professional – Mastery Level** is awarded when a person passes three ICCP Examinations at the 70% or higher score.

The exams required to earn these designation are CORE Information Technologies Examination, Data Warehousing examination, plus one of I.T. Management (Leadership and Management track), Business Information Systems (Business Analytics Track), Data Resources Management (Data Analysis & Design Track), Systems Development (Data Integration Track), Systems Security or Database Administration (Administration & Technology Track).

The ICCP is a not-for-profit organization that has been testing computer Programmers, systems analysts, I.T. Managers and systems developers Since 1973, on a global basis.

Passing the examinations also allows an individual to simultaneously work towards a college degree in computing or business information systems.
